How many times can two people fail to end it all? *Failsafe* is an unapologetically dark new comedy about a relationship forged in the depths of desperation.

Presented as part of Rhymes With Purple 2025 Fringe season, and created by New York-based company Trophy Wife, audiences can expect a bleakly hilarious exploration of mental health, sex and human connection.

The show follows two friends: Ivy, who is certain suicide is the answer, but refuses to die alone. And Jones, content with death, but only if he doesn't die a virgin. Four failed attempts later, they're still breathing.

Failsafe takes a taboo subject and slices it open with razor-sharp wit. Developed in New York's experimental theatre scene, Failsafe makes its EdFringe debut - and is part of the first season of theatre to be presented at the festival at Dovecot Studios.

"The making of Failsafe has been a profoundly cathartic process," says playwright Phil Carroll. "One that required us to examine the ugliest little parts of ourselves under a microscope until they started to look beautiful. We hope audiences find comfort in this examination, that they also have ugliness they need exorcised on stage."
